The Bears will be strategically placed in streets, parks, and public spaces, transforming our community into an open air galley.

The sculptures will then be sold at auction to raise much-needed funds for YMCA Tayside, supporting the work to provide a variety of youth work services to young people aged 8-25, mainly from disadvantaged backgrounds.
