



The Bear has been created by Wild in Art's Creative Team and has been purposefully designed to act as a 3D blank canvas to enable artists to develop their own unique work of art. These sculptures are manufactured using a mixture of Class II fire-retardant laminating resin and chopped, roving fibreglass over an initial brushed-on layer of polyester gel coat. Each Bear is finished with a primer and is ready to paint.

### Sculpture Outlines

- Please complete your proposed design on the outline provided.
- Submitted artwork must be no larger than A4.
- Supporting materials are accepted but please keep them to a minimum.
- All submitted application materials will not be returned.
- Please remember to keep copies of your application form and all associated materials.

Entries must be high resolution for display purposes and be in either JPG or PDF format.

Attachments must not exceed a file size of 2MB and must be emailed to beartrail@ymcatayside.com

We are so glad you are considering supporting our Bear Trail and submitting a design for this adventure. Your design will go into a longlist, and chosen designs will then go before our sponsors to choose their favourite design! On the 3rd of November 2025, we will host an open session for artists who want to come and learn more about YMCA Tayside if they feel it would benefit their design. This will be hosted at 19 Atholl Street, Perth between 1pm-3pm.

#### **Benefits Include**

### Part of the pack

#### How do I get involved?

Subject to being selected by a panel, your design will be included in the Design Portfolio, which is presented to sponsors. Sponsors choose their favourite artwork, and if yours is picked, you then apply the design to a sculpture.

#### **Chosen Artwork**

Commissioned artists will receive £1,000 upon completion of their artwork. Your work will be recognised across all printed material and other event collateral, including the sculpture's plaque, the official trail map, website and mobile app.

### **Design and Materials**

When planning your design, you should bear the following points in mind:

- You may submit up to two designs.
- You will be required to sign our standard terms and conditions agreement, included below for each design you submit.
- Designs should be appropriate for public display, bearing in mind that the audience will be broad-based and of all ages.
- Designs that are overtly religious, political, or sexual in nature will not be accepted.
- We cannot accept designs which infringe on 3rd party Intellectual Property i.e. licensed film, book or tv characters, emoji's etc. This extends to IP relating to celebrity image rights, album art and all other forms of existing visual art, which cannot be used without the express written permission of the author or owner.
- Artists may alter the basic sculpture shape, but if doing so, must ensure the finished work remains structurally intact. It is recommended that only artists experienced in working with fibreglass submit designs that use this process.
- Remember that the public will touch and interact with your sculpture. Some people may even rest or sit on your sculpture.
   Therefore, any attachments must be robust and able to withstand this handling (including, potentially, the weight of an adult), not be likely to cause any injury, and must be durable in an outside environment.
- Project painting spaces will be provided to create your Bear in Perth City Centre. Should you wish to paint your sculpture in
  your own studio, you will be responsible for its collection and delivery back to the space and all associated costs. Please be
  aware of the size and weight of the sculptures when considering this option.
- While we welcome all art forms, experience has taught us that collage and/ or sticking paper or paper-based products onto the sculpture does not prove as effective as painting or mosaics. Please consider this before submitting your design and be mindful that most sculptures will be positioned outdoors.
- When placed on the streets, each sculpture is fixed to a base, artists are requested to keep the base area clear of any attachments.
- Artist materials are not provided. We recommend the use of water-based acrylic paints, although artificial resin paint or twocomponent paint can also be used to paint or spray a design. We do not recommend the use of permanent markers or
  solvent-based pens, which may react with the varnish. To complete your sculpture, it must be finished with a waterproof, nonyellowing varnish, which will be provided.
- Artists will not be responsible for placing their sculptures on the streets or collecting them at the end the event. However, we do ask artists to be available during and after the event for any touch-up that may be required. If an artist is unavailable, another artist will carry out this work.
- Additionally, neither corporate logos nor advertising is allowed.

### Terms & Conditions

- 1. The project is open to all artists, amateur or professional.
- 2. You may submit up to two applications.
- 3.All terms and conditions in this application form a part of the agreement between you and YMCA Tayside in connection with Bears Big Adventure Trail and by submitting your work you are agreeing to be bound by all terms and conditions in this application form. You must be the sole author and owner of all intellectual property rights of the work entered, or if the work is/are not your own in full, you must have sole permission in writing from the copyright owner/s to use his/her work. Source material or proof of permission in use of another person's work must be made available on request by the selection panel. YMCA Tayside does not accept liability in the publication of any reproduced art.
- 4.The design must represent a piece of work that you have the ability to reproduce on a threedimensional sculpture
- 5.Any additions or modifications to the Bear must be sufficiently strong to maintain structural integrity of the sculpture and must not cause injury.
- 6.To enter, the work must be received by the team by the closing date of the 12<sup>th</sup> of December 2025.

  All entries must be accompanied by a completed artist submission form.
- 7. No allowances will be made for work that arrives later than the deadline.
- 8. By completing the Artist Submission Form and submitting your Bear designs you consent that all data provided by you may be used by YMCA Tayside and Wild in Art for marketing, communications and evaluation purposes unless you opt out in writing. A copy of YMCA Tayside's Privacy Policy will be made available on request.
- 9. Copyright and all other IP Rights in the design belong to and remain with the Artist. However, subject to YMCA Tayside paying the £1,000 fee, the Artist grants to YMCA Tayside and Wild In Art an irrevocable royalty free licence to use the completed artwork for their purposes in connection with the Event, Bears Big Adventure Trail, and for future materials regarding the trail.
- 10. You consent to the use of your work, name and photograph in any promotional material carried out by YMCA Tayside and Wild in Art without any further compensation.
- 11. Your Work will be reviewed by YMCA Tayside and Wild in Art prior to being shown to the Event Sponsors.
- 12. Work will be commissioned following confirmation by the Event Sponsors. This decision on all matters relating to the Work selected to be used is final. No further correspondence will be entered into.
- 13. Upon commissioning, YMCA Tayside will enter into a separate contract with you to include an agreed schedule and the terms and conditions of engagement.
- 14. Upon commissioning, YMCA Tayside will provide the Bear at no cost to you. Cost of materials is your responsibility with the exception of varnish which will be provided. If you are not able to paint the Bear in the public painting space you will be responsible for cost of transporting the Bear to your studio or place of painting and returning to the designated painting space in Perth unless otherwise agreed in writing with YMCA Tayside.
- 15. You will provide a list of artist materials specifically paint, brand and colours used in the application on the Bear.
- 16.YMCA Tayside reserves the right to withhold any fee payable to you in connection with the event if in its sole opinion the quality of the finished work provided falls below that which can be reasonably expected for public display and/ or is substantially different for the design you submitted.
